

BISHOP'S CUP TEAM RULES

The Bishop's Cup is a distinguished honor granted to the winning team of the Bishop's Invitational Golf Tournament. The team awarded will have the honor of their associated parish/school name in addition to the individual golfer's names engraved on the Bishop Cup's faceplate with the year it was won. The parish/school associated with the team will house and display the trophy for one year following the tournament or until the next year's tournament date, whichever comes first.

In order for a team to be eligible to play as a Bishop's Cup team, one of the following must apply.

- 1. All four golfers playing must be active members of the same Dallas Diocesan parish.
- 2. All four golfers playing must be graduated alumni from the same Dallas Catholic high school. These include Bishop Dunne, Bishop Lynch, Cistercian, Jesuit, John Paul II, Ursuline, Cristo Rey, The Highlands School and Notre Dame School.
- **3.** The team must be sponsored by and playing on behalf of a Dallas Diocesan parish or entity, or Dallas Catholic high school.

Players competing for the Bishop's Cup will play on the Stonebriar Country Club's elite Dye Course (also known as the Club Course). Limited to a maximum number of (36) teams. Teams will be accommodated on a first come first serve basis, so register early to ensure your spot.

**All eligible teams must denote upon signing up if they are a Bishop's Cup team and which associated parish/school they are playing on behalf of. Failure to do so could result in improper course placement, therefore losing eligibility to win the Cup.
